1. The BRIDGE- Connecting Mobility and Disability - A Project dealing with the mobility problem of youth with disabilities. The project's main aim is to enable youth with disability to actively participate in creating and developing civil society by joining events and other activities, which will be prepared with proper conditions to travel and experience things that weren't available for them before.

On the 14th of April 2005, in Wroclaw the first and opening conference “The Disabled and The Facilitator - a Complex Relationship” took place and the whole Project finally kicked off. 20 participants started the discussions about different disabilities and then talked about the relationship between the disabled person and the facilitator. Accordingly to the aim, disabled youth were present all the time - both during the workshops and parties so that they could give us their opinion and a very important input.



3. The second conference “Design & Disability” took place in Delft, from the 27-29th of May 2005. AEGEE Delft organized this conference dealing

with design and disability. Design is not only about architectural and technical barriers but also includes psychological and social aspects. More details are here:

The workshop started off by introducing the project to participants, explaining the aims and after a question session followed, leading onto a discussion, explanations and comments from participants who were already active in the project and been to the various workshops and conferences of The BRIDGE. Questions like - how can we improve the mobility of disabled youth and also ways to attract people were tackled.

All participants of the workshop were really into the subject and really believe in this project, which makes us even more enthusiastic to work on this sensitive and delicate issue.
